

The scope of the contract is to supply Hydra and Crane along with operator & helper to ISRPL Panipat

Technical Pre-Qualification Criteria for Bidders

Bidder to have Work Orders for supply of 14MT Hydra and 40MT Crane of similar capacity (not less) in past 5 years for minimum duration of 6 months. Bidder to submit relevant documentation for the same.

The following details are to be submitted along with the Technical Offer:

1. The details of the Crane and Hydra (like make, model etc)
2. Mobilization Time required for Crane and Hydra

General Conditions:

1. All PPE is within the scope of Contractor.
2. Contractor shall mobilize experienced operators for the crane and hydra.
3. All lodging, fooding, boarding, transportation of manpower is within Contractor's Scope.
4. Contractor to make Temporary/Permanent Gatepass for the persons' deployed vide this contract as per the rules and regulations laid by ISRPL. ESIC is mandatory.
5. No mobilization/demobilization cost shall be given for the Hydra and Crane.
6. Crane and Hydra specifications has been mentioned in details in the SOR.
7. The Statutory Load Test for the Crane and Hydra shall not older than 3 weeks before mobilisation.
8. The Crane and Hydra shall be considered mobilized only after submission of all documents and fulfilling the requirements of the Contract.
9. Crane and Hydra to be provided with a Operator and Helper. In case of absence of Operator or Helper Breakdown deduction shall be applicable.
10. Diesel for the Crane and Hydra is under ISRPL Scope. Contractor to ensure that the Diesel Tank is having lock and Key provision.
11. Financial Qualification criteria:

FINANCIAL PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC)

1. Bidders must have an Average Turnover of at least 2 times of the ISRPL annualised estimated cost of the work during last 3 financial years.

2. Bidders must have experience of having successfully carried out and completed similar work during last 3 financial years ending last day of the month previous to the month in which bids are invited, of which experience should be any one of the following

a. Three similar completed works, each costing not less than the amount equal to 35% of the annualised estimated cost.

or

b. Two similar completed works, each costing not less than the amount equal to 45% of the annualised estimated cost.

or

c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 75% of the annualised estimated cost.

3. The Vendor must have a positive Net Worth for the last three financial years (Audited Annual accounts statements are required to be submitted)

4. The Vendor's business should not be into continuous cash losses for last three financial years.
